William F. Pergine, age 67, devoted husband of Marion J. (Sasse) Pergine, of Royersford, PA passed away unexpectedly at home on Tuesday, October 22, 2013 of natural causes. Born in Conshohocken, PA, he was a son of the late Nicholas and Agnes (Mullen) Pergine. Bill was a member of Sacred Heart Roman Catholic church in Royersford. 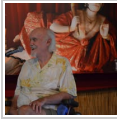
